I have long believed that St. Matthew's is a very special place, the embodiment in so many ways of what it means to be a church. 

#### **HOW TO HELP NEAR ST. MATT'S:**

- Sew masks and surgical caps for hospitals.




#### Learn to **ZOOM!**

Do you want to join one of our St. Matt's virtual connections but not sure how? Follow the instructions here. If you still need help, please call the church office at 703-430-2121. We'd love to "see" you online.

- 1. Find the Zoom ID listed under the "Virtual Connection" on the St. Matt's website, Friday Flash, or Online Announcements. For example: Bingo Night with Dave meets on Thursday Nights at 7:00pm. The Zoom Meeting ID is 743 731 742
- 2. Open the Zoom website at https://www.zoom.us
- 3. Near the top of the screen (in blue letters) you will see the words "Join A Meeting" Click on that. It will take you to the next screen where you can enter that Meeting ID number.
- 4. You may see a dialog box prompting you to "Open the application." Click "Open Zoom."
- 5. If your computer camera is turned on, you will see a video preview of yourself and given the option of "Joining with Video" or "Joining without Video." Choose whichever you're more comfortable with.
- 6. It may ask to allow to use computer audio and video. You want to do this so that you can participate in the meeting.
- 7. At that point, you should see other meeting members (unless you're the first one there). You should be in the meeting! Congrats!

If you can't see the meeting (or yourself), the camera privacy may be turned off in your Settings on your computer. If this happens, go into your "Settings" and "Camera Privacy" and "allow apps to use your camera." If you'd like to test your video and audio before logging into a meeting or event, you can go to the zoom test page at https://zoom.us/test
